- Your snowmobile trails are maintained by volunteers!
  - We are known as snowmobile club members. You can be one too.
- The state of Wisconsin and counties do not provide workers or resources.
  - They do not work to keep your trails open.
- Funding is provided by the county and state snowmobile associations for the clubs to do trail maintenance.
- Trail maintenance includes signs, clearing, and grooming.
- All labor is volunteered by snowmobile clubs and club members.
  - Currently trails are provided by the few and enjoyed by many... you can help!
- Don't assume the trails will be ready to ride... get involved today!

### ✓ Snow happens!

- We do get snow.

- Work gets done to prepare for the snow, when there is no snow.
  - Easements have to be acquired.
  - Routes must be approved.
  - Trails must be cleared of obstacles.
  - Signs must be placed and removed.
